

Attention: INTERNATIONAL STUDENT APPLICANTS REQUIRING AN F-1 STUDENT VISA OR A J-1 EXCHANGE VISA MUST RETURN THIS FORM.

Before the American Embassy will issue a student visa to study at Loyola University New Orleans, the prospective student must show evidence that he/she has access to a minimum of \$ 41,280.00 per year while in the United States. This is the minimum cost of living and studying for a single international university student for nine months. Costs for married students bringing their families will be higher.

The person signing this Affidavit of Support is agreeing to provide at least this amount per year for the student. The sponsor's signature must be certified by a bank official where the funds are located. If it is not certified, it will not be accepted. No final decision on admission will be made until this document is received.
