 Academic Year: 2015-16

The 2+2 articulation agreement between Delgado and Loyola allows a student who completes certain prescribed courses in the Associate of Applied Science degree in Accounting at Delgado to transfer to Loyola's College of Business as a Junior and complete a Bachelor of Accountancy degree in an additional two years or 60 credit hours. Students must meet Loyola's admissions standards and complete all Loyola degree requirements. Delgado courses which satisfy Loyola requirements and the equivalent courses are summarized below.

**Transfer credit for approved courses will be awarded only for courses in which a C or higher was earned.**
