Miami-Dade College A.A. to Loyola B.A. in Studio Arts
Academic Year: 2015-16

The 2+2 articulation agreement between Miami-Dade College and Loyola allows a student who completes certain prescribed courses in eligible Associate's degree programs Miami-Dade to transfer to Loyola as a Junior and complete a Bachelor of Arts degree in Studio Arts in an additional two years or 60 credit hours. Students must meet Loyola's admissions standards and complete all Loyola degree requirements. Miami-Dade courses which satisfy Loyola requirements and the equivalent courses are summarized below.

Transfer credit for approved courses will be awarded only for courses in which a C or higher was earned.
